

**Resolution to Approve the Institutionalization of the \$75 per Student per Semester
Transportation Fee**

Whereas Monroe Community College has arranged an agreement between itself and the Rochester Regional Transit Service to provide Universal Bus Pass transportation services to Monroe Community College Students; and


Whereas the Monroe Community College Student Government Association has determined through investigation that approximately 14% of Monroe Community College Students regularly use the Universal Buss Pass Transportation Service based upon 2018-2019 ridership data; and

Whereas the proposed \$75 Transportation Fee shall not be applied to the Students of the Monroe Community College Public Safety Training Center, of whom will receive no benefit from the institutionalization of the aforementioned fee; and

Whereas the proposed Transportation Fee has been reduced to \$75 per Student per Semester, as opposed to the original proposal, \$150 per Student per Semester, and as such, no longer presents a substantial financial burden to the large majority of Students whom already pay \$75 per semester for Parking Services, which shall be included within the proposed \$75 Transportation Fee; now, therefore be it

Resolved that the Monroe Community College Student Government Association Senate, present and voting, approve the institutionalization of the proposed \$75 per Student per Semester Transportation Fee.
