## **New Pay-Stub Format With Your Bi-weekly Paycheck**

There will be a new look to your pay stub beginning with the September 3, 2009 check run. Attached is a sample of the new format. Below is a brief description of the changes:

'<u>Employee Current' column</u> – The data in this column remains the same as before - the heading has changed to note these deductions/benefits are paid by the employee for the current pay period.

'<u>Employee YTD' column</u> – The data in this column remains the same as before - the heading has changed to note these deductions/benefits are paid by the employee and accumulate to a year-to-date (calendar year) amount.

<u>'Employer Current' column</u> - This is a new column and lists the cost of benefits the College has incurred on your behalf for the current pay period.

'<u>Employer YTD' column</u> – This is a new column and will provide a year-to-date (calendar year) accumulation of the benefits the College has incurred on your behalf. This will provide valuable information regarding the benefits you receive at MCC.

<u>'Life Insurance Taxable – YTD'</u> - This represents the taxable life insurance (your coverage over \$50,000 paid by the College) that is added to your W-2 each year.
