Spring 2020 S/P Grades – Transfer Policies

As of May 28, 2020

Nazareth College:

S/P grades will be accepted except in the nursing and occupational therapy programs for their prerequisite courses like Anatomy and Physiology. Contact: Ann Knaak <u>aknaak9@naz.edu</u>

Roberts Wesleyan College

If the MCC transcript states P is = to C- or better, will transfer in the course and will accept a grade of S. Students need the actual grade for Nursing prerequisites. Contact: Mary Sasso <u>sasso mary@roberts.edu</u>

Rochester Institute of Technology:

Pass or Satisfactory (P/S) grades will be accepted. Contact: Jen Zirnheld <u>jmzadm@rit.edu</u>

St. John Fisher College:

Satisfactory or Pass (S/P) grades will be accepted. For majors requiring a specific grade equivalent for progression in the program, proof that a S/P grade meets the minimum requirement may be requested.

<u>Pharmacy</u>

Prefers applicants receive an actual letter grade (ABC) for all math and science courses. In the absence of an actual letter grade, alternative grades (S or P) will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Education

Pass or Satisfactory (P/S) grades will be accepted. For courses that are required for teacher certification, S grades for undergraduate courses and B- for graduate courses are required.

Nursing

For an MCC applicant who has taken BIO 144 & 145, BIO 202, BIO 117 or 217, CHE 124, MTH 160, PSY 212 or PHL 103 in the Spring:

- S grade the course will meet the prerequisite, but the student will get credit for "C" (2.0) quality points on the perquisite calculation.
- P grade the course will NOT meet the prerequisite and this course must be retaken with a grade of "C" of higher; the student will get credit for "C-" (1.7) quality points on the prerequisite calculation.

Arts & Sciences

Pass or Satisfactory (P/S) grades will be accepted.

School of Business

Prefers applicants to receive an actual letter grade (A, B, C).

In the absence of an actual letter grade, alternative grades (e.g., S or P) will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Sport Management

Will only accept grades of C (meaning S and not P) for application to their major.

SUNY Brockport:

"S" grades will transfer to satisfy major/minor/general education requirements.

"P" grades will transfer to satisfy general education requirements but may not satisfy major/minor requirements that require a C or higher.

If taken during the spring 2020 semester, courses with pass/fail or satisfactory/unsatisfactory grades will be accepted for transfer credit to Geneseo.

Pass or Satisfactory (P/S) grades will be accepted.

Students in certain majors who select P/S/U grading for a course may not be able to count that course toward certain major or major prerequisites. The following majors are affected:

- <u>Nursing</u> (Major prerequisites and requirements)
- Occupational Therapy (Major prerequisites and requirements)
- <u>Accounting</u> (Major requirements only. ACC 101 and 102 may be taken P/S/U.
