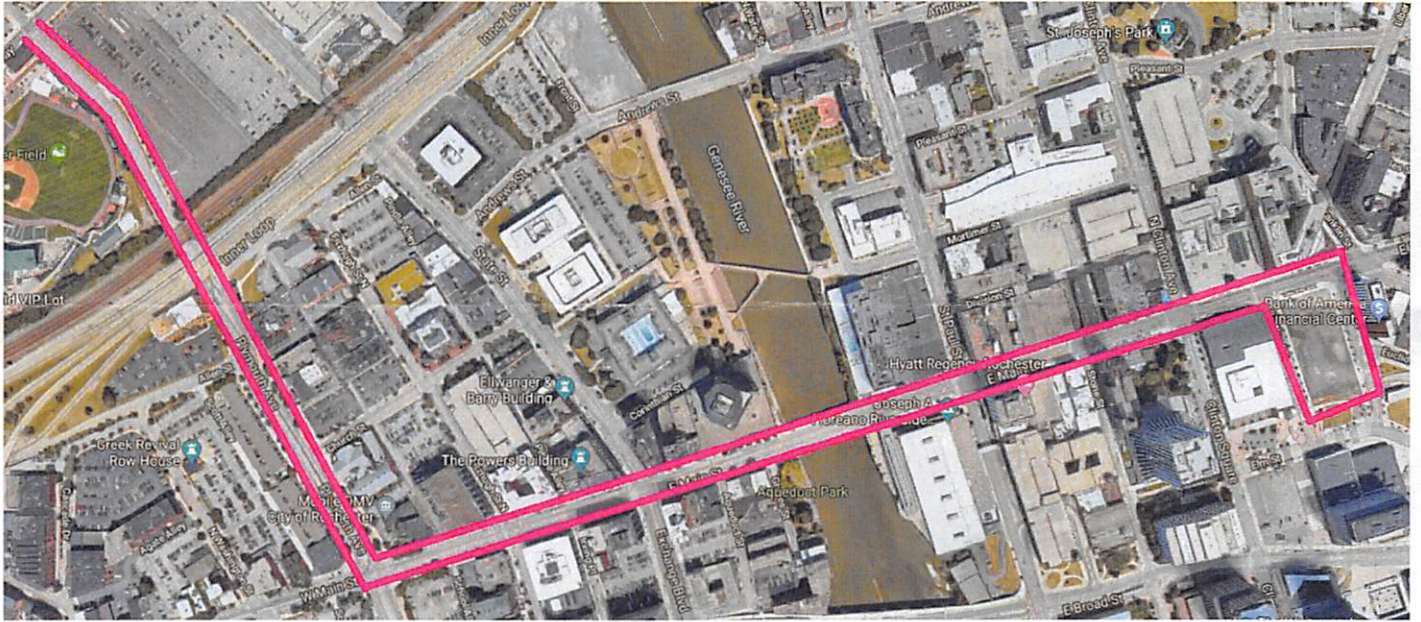


# 2019 COURSE MAP

6. Turn left of Andrew Langston Way
7. Turn left on East Main Street
8. Turn right on Plymouth Avenue
