SUNY ONLINE

- MCC has been selected to offer three degree programs in the first year (2019-2020) of the relaunched SUNY Online: Accounting, Mathematics, and Psychology.
- SUNY is providing professional development, technical assistance, marketing, and student concierge services.
- All programs will have online transfer SUNY options.
