

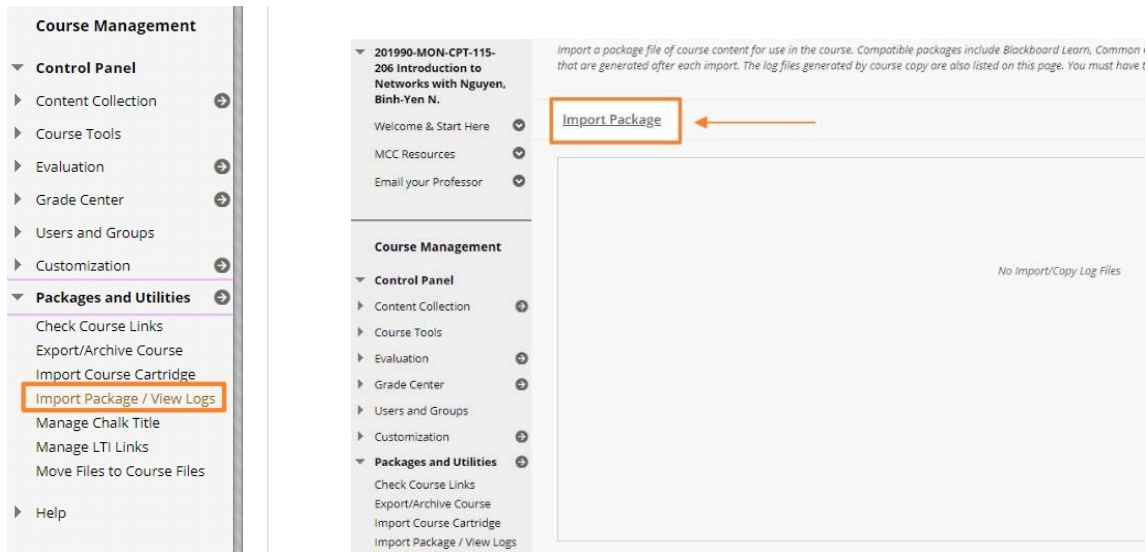


How to Import Content Area ‘Scholarship Info’

You can import the ‘Scholarship Info’ content area to your course in three steps as following:

1. Control Panel > Packages and Utilities > Import Package / View Logs > Import Package



2. Select a Package > Browse My Computer > Go to the directory where file “ExportFile_Scholarship-Online” is saved and select it.






