Who can participate?

Students must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States pursuing post-secondary education to be eligible for TRIO SSS, and meet one of the following criteria: **first-generation college student**, **considered low-income based on federal income guidelines**, or have a documented disability (disclosure is voluntary and confidential; student must be registered with the MCC Disability Services Office).
