Medea Rambish graduated with her Doctor of Education (Higher Education Administration) from Widener University, with an M.A. in Language and Literacy and a B.A. in English from Pennsylvania State University.

In her current position as Dean of Developmental Education and College Readiness at Wabaunsee Community College, she “provided leadership for a centralized Developmental Education division, with responsibility for developmental coursework and faculty, learning assistance services, and college readiness partnerships.” Medea led a partnership with 24 high schools that promoted early college readiness.

In her previous position as Interim Dean of Academic Support Initiatives and Director of Developmental Education at Montgomery County Community College, Medea provided leadership in the areas of Developmental Education: coursework, tutorial services, remediation initiatives, placement and other testing services, just to name a few. Medea wrote the Middle States Program Review Report section and participated in grant development opportunities to increase and improve comprehensive services to at-risk students.

As an instructor, Medea taught underprepared students strategies to help make them successful in colleges. She has organized several conferences, presented and served on several panels, has had a leadership role on several committees, and has served on both state and national boards.
