## Making Data Accessible, Understandable, Actionable

THREE-YEAR GRADUATION RATES



(2015 COHORT) 2018 IPEDS: Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS); First time in-college, full-time degree/certificate-seeking students starting in fall.

#### SIX-YEAR GRADUATION RATES(MAIN COHORT)



VFA – Main Cohort: Voluntary Framework of Accountability (VFA); All students new to MCC in the fall term who earned a high school diploma or GED.

#### FALL-TO-FALL RETENTION RATES



FROM FALL 2017 TO NEXT FALL

All students enrolled in a fall term excluding graduates and nonmatriculated; this produces the cohort that is tracked to the next fall term.

#### COURSE COMPLETION RATES



FALL 2018

The credit hours completed in a term with a "C" or better divided by all course credit hours attempted in the specified term.
