Executive Summary of Feedback Received from the Policy Portal to the Copyright and Faculty Ownership of Intellectual Property Policy

The Copyright and Faculty Ownership of Intellectual Property Policy was posted on MCC's Policy Portal for 30-day period, ended December 5, 2024. There was one comment received.

There was one comment on the use of the word, tapes, in the following sentence from the policy:

1. "In certain types of courses, they may also prepare for individual or classroom use slides, tapes, photographs, displays, models, and similar materials."

The commenter noted that this is a dated term and suggested MCC update the sentence to read:

"In certain types of courses, they may also prepare electronic and/or physical media for individual or classroom use, such as videos, audio clips, photos, displays, models, interactive simulations, and similar materials."

Administrative Response #1:

• This revision would not only eliminate the outdated term, tapes, but also include newer media. The administration thanks the commenter and will make the change before sending the policy to the Board of Trustees.
