### Facts about **Breast Cancer**

- One in eight women or 12.6% of all women will get breast cancer in her lifetime.
- Breast cancer is the leading cause of cancer death in women between the ages of 15 and 54, and the second cause of cancer death in women 55-74.
- Over eighty percent of breast lumps are not cancerous, but benign such as fibrocystic breast disease.
- You are never too young to develop breast cancer! Breast Self-Exams should begin by the age of twenty.
- First sign of breast cancer usually shows up on a woman's mammogram before it can be felt or any other symptoms are present.
