B. Approval of the July 21, 2009 meeting minutes.

Speaker Carey called for a motion to approve the minutes for the July 21, 2009 Senate meeting.

Discussion: Senator Cohen motioned to make a correction to New Business Action Item 1a: "Be it resolved, the Monroe Community College Brighton Campus Student Government Association Senate approves Jason Childers as President..." It should read "...approves Jason Childers as Vice President..." Senator Dawley seconded the motion. **A vote was taken.**

III. REPORTS

A. Speaker

Speaker Carey...
