Resolution to approve the allocation of funds to the Travel Club

Whereas the Contingency funding process has been adopted by the Student Government Association for this year.

Whereas the Travel Club have requested funds for an educational and social trip to Cancun, Mexico

Whereas the Travel Club is requesting \$4,498 from the SGA Contingency fund.

Whereas the total cost of this trip is \$28,758.

Whereas each student going on this trip will be paying \$742 out of pocket to attend this trip

Whereas this is an all-inclusive trip and is handled differently than regular trips.

Whereas the travel club has been doing multiple fundraisers for this trip which include selling saving around Rochester coupon books, silent auction in December and selling March Mania (a 10% off coupon for the student run café Food for Thought on campus).

Whereas the purpose of the trip is to learn about the different destination zones that people vacation at. The students going are all Hospitality majors that upon graduation will need to be aware of for the promotion of them. Their clients will be more receptive of our recommendations if they have firsthand knowledge over just handing them a brochure.
