


Monroe Community College Alumni Weekend 2005



George C. Monagan, Jr.

Founding Faculty Member • Professor Emeritus • Athletic Director • Poet 1925 - 2005

One of the college's pioneers, George C. Monagan Jr. served the Monroe Community College community for 26 years, and remained involved as a volunteer for almost two decades into his retirement. George often returned to campus and remained enthusiastically involved in planning athletic, alumni and student scholarship events at the college. George was always eager to cheer on MCC Tribunes.

George built many lasting traditions at our community college.

From the Sports Hall of Fame to the National Youth Sports Program hosted at MCC each summer, George's commitment to our area's youth and education was a role model for us all.




MCC Tribunes Soccer
