Brighton Campus Getting a New Look Redesign is aimed at improving traffic flow and enhancing its entrance.



BUS STOP

Is located in the rear of the campus, in front of the R. Thomas Flynn Campus Center; public buses also stop on East Henrietta Road. Only buses are allowed in lanes in front of the Flynn Campus Center on Center Road; all other vehicular traffic is prohibited.

Check **www.rgrta.com** for route information and the most current schedules. Coming: Electronic signs displaying bus arrival information will be posted in the Gilman Lounge and in the North Faculty Tower lobby (Building 5).

The East Henrietta Road bus stop will be relocated adjacent to Lot A off Campus Drive; public bus service at this site is anticipated to begin 1/2/14.

WHEELCHAIR VANS/BUSES

Pickup and drop-off are in the circle at the north entrance to the R. Thomas Flynn Campus Center on Center Road.

FRONT ENTRANCE TO THE COLLEGE

Will feature a campus green. A new entrance to the Spina Administration Building will have staircases to the second floor of the building; anticipated opening is 1/2/14. Accessibility for people with disabilities is unchanged.

VISITOR PARKING

Temporarily in Lot C (enter through Lot D) through 10/31/13.

Metered visitor parking spaces are located near the MCC Theatre on Arts and Residence lanes. Visitors may also request e-permits from MCC departments in advance to park in other authorized areas.

New visitor parking lot adjacent to the campus green is anticipated to open 11/1/13.

Coming: A cell phone waiting area with limited spaces will be located in Lot M; vehicles must remain occupied.

INFORMATION DESK

Information desk in the Spina Administration Building remains open. To assist visitors during construction, additional information desks are located at the entrance to the North Faculty Tower (Building 5) and in the R. Thomas Flynn Campus Center atrium.
