These references may be from an individual such as an employer, teacher, extracurricular activity advisor, minister, or volunteer organization director. Original, signed reference letters should clearly state the writer's relationship to the applicant.
- For <u>high school seniors</u>, an official high school transcript plus an official copy of your SAT and/or ACT scores. Note: the transcript must contain a straight, not weighted, cumulative numeric grade point average through grade 11 for high school seniors or through grade 12 if you have graduated. (If required by the applicant's high school, these may be sent directly from the high school guidance office to Reliant at the address below.)
- For <u>currently enrolled college</u> or university students, a copy of all college transcripts.

Application Deadline

Applications must be delivered or postmarked by March 12, 2010.

Selection Process

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on their demonstration of the credit union philosophy of "people helping people," involvement in community service and volunteer activities, academic performance, and information provided through essay questions and references.

Scholarship winners will be notified on or before June 11, 2010.
