Directions to Canal Hall (our Residence Hall that is open for tours):

As you are standing in the Marketplace and facing Dunkin Donuts, go to the left. Straight ahead is a set of double doors with an exit sign above them; go through these doors and there will be a second set of doors straight ahead to go through. Head down the stairs and at the bottom of the stairs go through the doors leading outside. Once outside, turn to the right and keep straight on the sidewalk. You will pass the pond on your right. Follow the path curving to the right that is closest to the pond (the black paved path). Continue on this path and over the footbridge. The building directly in front of you is Canal Hall.

Take a left at the end of the hallway. Straight ahead of you, you will see a set of doors that says "Gilman Lounge." Go straight down the hallway and through the doors. There will be a second set of doors straight in front of you, go through those which will lead you outside. Go left on the sidewalk, then go straight until you reach the road, then turn right (on the sidewalk). Go straight until you see a red sign that says "No Parking MCC Shuttle Loading & Unloading Only." You can wait there for the shuttle.

Admissions Information
