

## Kimberly Evans-Dame

Kimberly Evans-Dame received an Associate in Applied Sciences degree in Business Administration from Jamestown (NY) Community College. She went on to attend Nazareth College where she received her baccalaureate degree in Business Administration and, as a part of her academic program, served an internship with the Paychex Corporation, a national provider of payroll, benefits, and human resources outsourcing solutions for business.

Following graduation from Nazareth College, Ms. Evans-Dame was engaged as Personnel/Payroll Administrator for Upstate Milk Co-Op, a position she held for approximately one year before joining Liberty Pole Way, Inc. as a Business Manager. She remained there for the next two years, followed by a year as Personnel and Payroll Manager for Monroe Tractor.

The following year, Ms. Evans-Dame joined Hansford Manufacturing, a producer of automation assembly systems for the automotive, electronic, telecommunications, medical and semiconductor industries, where she remained for approximately six years in the role of Human Resources Generalist. During her tenure with Hansford, Ms. Evans-Dame returned to Nazareth College to begin graduate work. While engaged in her studies at Nazareth, Hansford closed its doors, and Ms. Evans-Dame went on to assume the role of Director of Human Resources for the Rochester Housing Authority, the regional public housing entity for the five-county Greater Rochester, New York region. RHA serves more than 20,000 low income, disabled, or elderly individuals annually, and has a staff component of approximately 200.

After receiving her Master of Science degree in Management, Ms. Evans-Dame became the Executive Director of Human Resources at Mohawk Valley Community College, the largest college between Albany and Syracuse, enrolling approximately 7,400 students. There she oversees all human resources and labor relations activities affecting between 900 and 1000 full- and part-time employees, including members of five unions. A member of the President's Cabinet, Ms. Evans-Dame combines leadership of an active, comprehensive HR department with participation in institutional strategic management including planning and finance.
