DID YOU KNOW... In 2007, Cornell University's admission acceptance rate of applicants was 31%. Since the Fall of 2007 over 80% of Monroe Community College students who have applied to Cornell through the Pathway to Success Program have been accepted to Cornell University. Thirty-five MCC students have enrolled at Cornell University through Pathway to Success since 2007.
