RE: Spring 2010 Enrollment Highlights

As of the census, MCC spring enrollment was 18,686 and 6,730.5 FTEs, up 7.0% and 9.4% respectively from last spring. The FTE enrollment comprises 108.5% of the census budget and marks a new spring enrollment record. The complete spring enrollment is projected to include another 290 FTEs that come from dual credit, law enforcement, and other late starting courses to be reported at the end of the spring semester.

- Admissions applications to the College were up 14.7% from last spring yielding 13.0% enrollment increase in admitted students (+400 students).
- Enrollment of first-time MCC students increased 6.4% (+93 students); transfer enrollment declined 7.6% (-60 students) from last spring. As a result of the record high fall enrollment the number of continuing students increased 8.0% (+1038 students) from last spring. The continuing students account for 85.1% of spring enrollment increase.
- Full-time enrollment increased 10.7% (+1082 students), part-time students increased 1.8% (+136 students) while the number of non-matriculated part-time students went down 9.0% (-170 students) compared to last spring.
- Enrollment of students taking all courses at Brighton or Extension sites increased 6.5% (+906 students), students taking all courses at DCC went up 16.6% (+257 students), PSTF enrollment decreased 16.4% (-95 students) from last spring. Brighton FTE's that account for 84.3% of semester FTE's were up 8.5% (+445.5 FTE); DCC FTE's were up 17.6% (+145.5 FTE) from last spring.
- The enrollment of students taking courses at Brighton and DCC increased 12.7% (+171 students) from last spring. This group of 1,513 students accounts for 8.1% of spring enrollment and 9.4% of the census FTE's.
- All age groups experienced enrollment increases from last spring. The largest gain was in students 20 - 24 years (+8.8%, +496 students) who represent 63% of spring enrollment. The median age of students by campus is: Brighton – 21; DCC – 22; Brighton/DCC – 22; PSTF – 38.

- SUNY Learning Network (SLN) enrollment increased 17.3% (+ 492 students) from last spring semester and stands at 3,339 students and 458.8 FTE. Sixty nine percent of SLN students are also taking face-to-face courses.
- College minority enrollment reached 31%. Campus minority proportions are: Brighton 26%, DCC 61%, Brighton/DCC 45% and PSTF 12%.
- The number of students receiving Federal or State grants (Pell or TAP) increased 20.5% (+1,639 students) from last spring. Fifty seven percent of all matriculated students enrolled in spring semester received federal or state financial aid grants.
- Enrollment from Monroe County increased 7.6% (+1098 students) from last spring. Out of county student population went up 3.9% (+120 students) compared to last spring.
- The enrollment of degree-seeking students increased 8.6% (+1,014 students) while the non-matriculated students decreased 8.5% (-165 students) from last spring. “2+2” and extended option program enrollment was flat compared to last spring.
