Resolution to approve Jason Childers to the position of Deputy Speaker of the MCC Student Government Association

Whereas, under Article III, Section 6.C.2 of the MCC Student Government Association Constitution, the Senate shall elect a Speaker from among their number, by two-thirds vote, at a scheduled meeting prior to the first day of classes in the Fall semester.
