# FACULTY ASSOCIATION "HONOR YOUR DREAM" SCHOLARSHIP

#### Purpose and Eligibility

The purpose of the FA scholarship(s) is to provide a monetary award to students in need. The scholarship will be awarded annually and the number of awards will be based on the available funds. Current criteria include that the student must:

- Be a full-time MCC student
- Have attended MCC for at least one academic year (or be in the process of completing their first year upon applying for this scholarship)
- Be planning (enrolled) to attend MCC for a second year
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5

### Funding for the Scholarship

 All members of FA are welcome to contribute to the scholarship fund at any time or during specific fundraising events.

#### Naming of the Scholarship

The Scholarship Committee will select an individual each year to be named the Scholarship Honoree. Members of the Faculty Association are welcome to submit a candidate whom they feel represents the best of MCC. The honoree will be recognized in the annual publications for the scholarship and identified on the scholarship award.

- The first Honor Your Dream Scholarship(s) will be awarded in honor of Carmen Powers.
- Honorees may be current, retired or deceased faculty who exemplify the meaning of supporting student success.

## Scholarship Committee

The FA President and Executive Committee have selected a member of Faculty Council to be the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and determine scholarship recipients.

## **Application Process**

Faculty may identify possible candidates and encourage them to apply for the scholarship. Application forms will be made available to all faculty and students on the FA Website and in the FA Office (7-205).

- Application forms will be available: February 1
- Application submission deadline: April 1
- FA Scholarship Committee will make the selections: May 1
- Scholarship Awards will be granted: June 1
