

Guidelines For Scholarship

Eligibility

Single mother of African-American descent Monroe County resident Presently enrolled in college or accepted for enrollment in the fall Proof of enrollment or acceptance is required

Application

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Final selection will be made by the Links Scholarship Committee.

Any change in academic plans after the original application is accepted may make the applicant ineligible.

All applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2013.

Process

Applicant who is awarded a scholarship will be notified on or before April 30, 2013. The award will be presented to the winner at the Links White Rose Luncheon on May 11, 2013.

The scholarship award will be sent to the directly to the college/university upon proof of enrollment.
