The Native American Education Scholarship was established by The Native American Education Foundation to provide financial support to deserving Native American students as they pursue their educational goals at Monroe Community College. The scholarship is made possible by the Native American Education Fund through JP Morgan Chase Bank. The Native American Education Scholarship will provide scholarships to Native American students with a preference for those residing in Western or Central New York.

STUDENT AWARD CRITERIA:

- Award will be given to MCC Students enrolled as a member of a recognized Northern American Indian tribe or Alaska Native tribe
- Preference given to student residing in Western or Central New York
- Student may be full or part-time in a degree or certificate program
- High school graduate with a minimum C average or GED recipient
- MCC student minimum 2.0 GPA, minimum 2.0 GPA for continued eligibility

The coordinator of MCC's Native American Initiative in conjunction with the Director of Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) will invite nominations from students and make recommendations to the Director of Financial Aid who will execute the award. Documentation is required as proof of enrollment in a recognized Northern American Indian tribe or Alaska Native tribe.

This scholarship application and the FAFSA results must be received by the MCC Financial Aid Office by Friday December 14, 2012. Scholarship winners will be notified by January 15, 2013.
