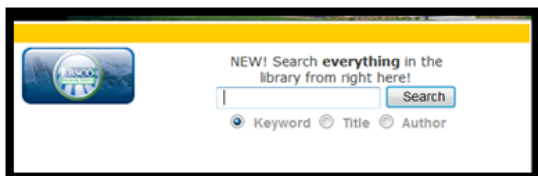

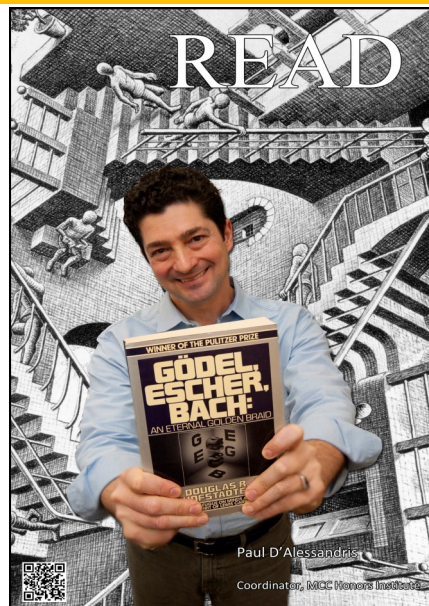
New All-in-One Search Tool

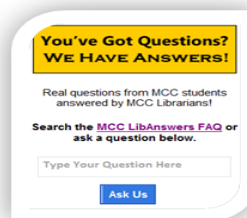
MyMCC Student Portal's Library Tab
