The FSA ID is your electronic passport to federal student aid online.

It's ready, you can [create an FSA ID now](https://fsaid.ed.gov).

Students, parents, and borrowers are required to use an FSA ID, made up of a username and password, to access certain U.S. Department of Education websites. Your FSA ID can be used to verify your identity when accessing your financial aid information and submitting your FAFSA.

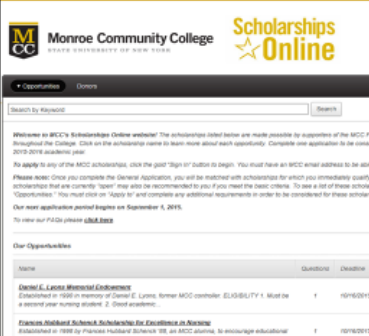
Students will need to use their social security number and date of birth for security purposes in order to access.
