### **Resolution to Approve the Funding of \$1500.00 to the Engineering Leadership Council**

Whereas, under Article III, Section 6.C.g of the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Constitution, the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Travel and Finance Committee has approved \$1,500 from the Senate Contingency Fund to the Engineering Leadership Council for “Design Build Fly” and

Whereas, a majority vote of the Senate is required to approve such funding, the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Travel and Finance Committee and Engineering Leadership Council asks the Senate to approve the funding of \$1,500.00 from the Senate Contingency Fund to sponsor the Engineering Leadership Council’s trip for “Design, Build, Fly”, and Whereas, the Engineering Leadership Council has been informed a representative from the club needs to be in attendance at the Public Senate Meeting, therefore be it
