He is also the Director of Science Education and Career Center and the Co-Director of UTeach at the University of Texas at Arlington. He has been responsible for guiding more than 70 in-service science teachers to their M.A. degree and has led efforts to improve the secondary math and science teacher preparation program at UT Arlington. Prior to serving in these administrative positions, he was a Lecturer and Undergraduate Advisor in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at UT Arlington.
