Betty P. Smith is a woman who has had a tremendous impact on the lives of many of MCC's adult students. This scholarship honors Betty and the contributions she has made to this College. It is her hope that this financial award will help adult students make their dreams of graduating from MCC a reality.

Purpose:

This scholarship is designed to help an adult (over the age of 25) student defray the costs associated with attending MCC.

Eligibility:

- Adult student (over age 25),
- Full-time status (carrying 12 credits or more, not including Transitional Studies courses),
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- **Have at least 18 MCC credits complete** (not including the current semester or Transitional Studies courses)
- Have at least one more regular (fall or spring) semester remaining at MCC. If you will be graduating this semester or over the summer you are not eligible.

Students will not be considered unless they meet **ALL** of the above requirements.

Criteria:

Demonstrated commitment to education and high level of motivation to achieve educational and personal goals.

Selection:

The selection committee will choose the scholarship(s) recipient based on a written essay, a personal interview, current academic record, and letter(s) of recommendation.

Award:

A one-time \$500 scholarship will be awarded at the Annual Student Awards Banquet on May 17, 2013. The recipient must be present at the banquet to accept the award.
