SPONSORS

At present we have 490 sponsors who are sponsoring 666 children in 439 families. We also have 617 children on our waiting list. Our sponsors and families are now supported by a program manager. If you have not had contact with the program manager for the area where your sponsored family lives, please do e-mail them and introduce yourself.

Our goal for this year is to sponsor every child and elder who is on our waiting list. Please do help by telling all your friends, acquaintances, groups, and neighbors about this program.

PROPANE

Since January 1st. OneSpirit and our sponsors and donors have purchased more than \$5000.00 in propane. Our money was matched by tribal funds and will also be matched by government funds. One of the people who received fuel, a grandmother who had the flu and had been without heat for a couple of weeks, was moved to tears when her propane was delivered.

PROJECT SHARE

In February we spent \$1350.00 with project SHARE and provided food for 175 people. This month (March), in our ongoing effort to provide families with nutritious meals, we are spending about \$2000.00 with project SHARE. In addition we are beginning to see families buying food for themselves through Project SHARE.

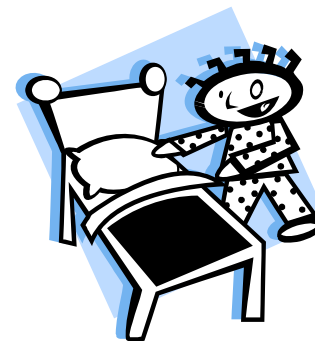


The cost of delivering the food each month is about \$500.00 plus we also buy food for families who do not have sponsors. OneSpirit has underwritten this expense in order to get Project SHARE established on the reservation.

Our purchases are now at a level where Project SHARE can begin to deliver food directly to a central location on the reservation (a huge savings for us) but we will still be paying our people to deliver to homes for those who do not have transportation. The people delivering the food are being paid for their gas and also, in the true spirit of a co-op, get food to compensate for their time.

THE BED PROJECT

We now have \$3000.00 towards our next truck load of beds. We also have a new manager for the bed project – Lynn McLaughlin. She will be keeping us up to date on plans and progress. Rex is still with us and helping Lynn plus managing other projects.

THE LAKOTA THEATRE

We are writing grants and contacting organizations like Project Hoop for support for this project. We are also looking for corporate sponsors. The timeline for touring the play both in the US and in Europe is now scheduled for 2007 with 2006 being the development year. The project has received grants in Europe and we now need to provide funding here in the US. WHAT WE NEED TO DO NOW

We are proud of what we have been able to accomplish in the short time that we have been OneSpirit. It is vital for the well-being of our children and families that we be able to continue to assist with the basic needs while at the same time supporting programs that bring economic development to the reservation. It will be through the economic development strategies that one day organizations such as OneSpirit will no longer be needed on Pine Ridge.

While the OneSpirit staff has been personally paying for program expenses, this arrangement cannot continue nor can sponsors be expected to meet all the needs of a family. We want to make the One Spirit Programs into a true team effort. We are writing grants and contacting both individual and corporate donors to obtain funding. We are also asking each sponsor to make a yearly donation of \$60.00 (\$5.00 per month) to help with program costs. It is our anticipation that within a year, we will have enough funds to supplement propane needs for families, handle the expense of Project SHARE, and to see the first Lakota Theatre Performance.
