

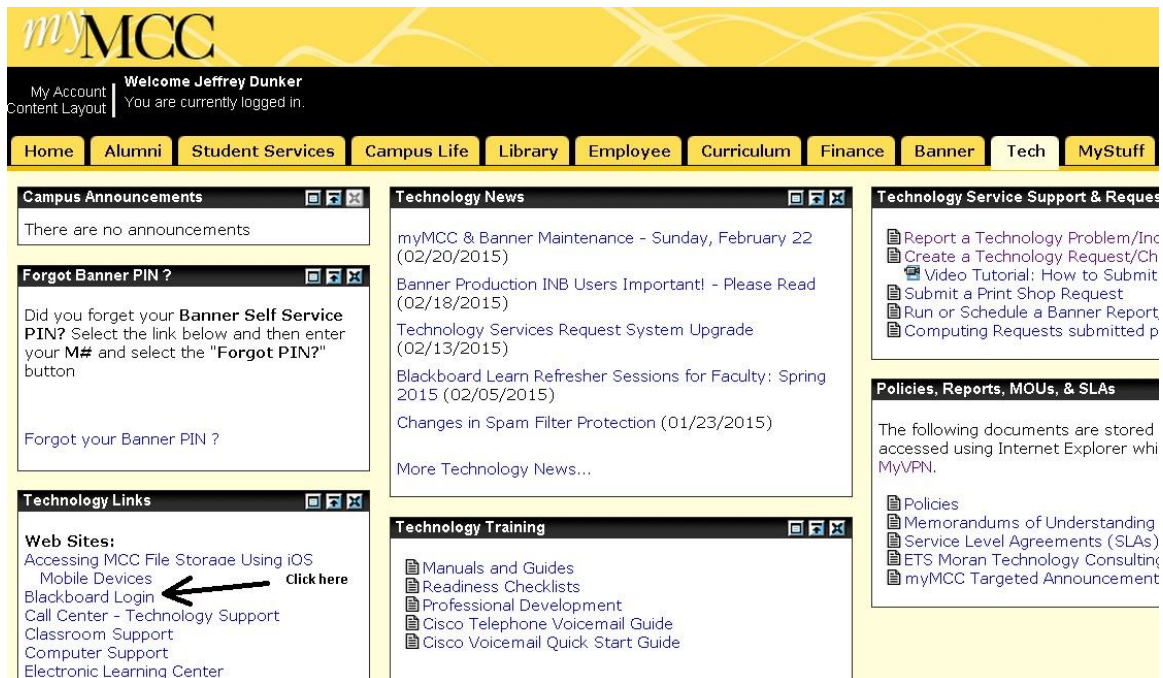
MCC Blackboard Login Instructions for Faculty and Staff
