ELIGIBILITY: Full or part-time students in good academic (2.25 GPA) and disciplinary standing,

who have been actively involved in the co-curricular program at MCC for a minimum

of two semesters.

Nominees must be potential graduates or individuals who will be leaving the College

upon conclusion of the current academic year.

CRITERIA: Students should personify such qualities as:

- Congeniality
- Tolerance

- Citizenship and trustworthiness

SELECTION: Award Selection Committees on each campus will choose the award recipients.

time member of the MCC faculty, staff, or administration.

Nominations must be typed and submitted (on the John J. Trevisan Co-Curricular Student Leadership Award nomination form) to the Brighton Campus Office of

Student Life & Leadership Development or the Damon Campus Center Office no later

than Friday, April 19, 2013.

Awards Banquet and presented with a plaque and \$200 cash.
