Resolutions for the January 24, 2012 MCC Student Government Association Senate Meeting

Resolution to approve the funding of \$2,500.00 to the Travel Club

Whereas, under Article II, Section 6.C.7 of the MCC Student Government Association Constitution, the MCC Student Government Association Travel and Finance Committee has approved \$2,500.00 from the Senate Contingency Fund to the Travel Club for an event called Royal Caribbean Cruise, and

Whereas, a majority vote of the Senate is required to approve such funding, the MCC Student Government Association Travel and Finance Committee asks the Senate to approve the funding of \$2,500.00 from the Senate Contingency Fund to sponsor Royal Caribbean Cruise, and

Whereas, the Travel Club has been informed a representative from the club needs to be in attendance at the Public Senate Meeting, therefore be it

Resolved, that the SGA Senate consents to the funding of \$2,500.00 to the Travel Club to sponsor the event Royal Caribbean Cruise.

Resolution to Revoke Charters

Whereas, under Section 3.4.3 of the MCC Student Government Association By-Laws, the SGA Senate is charged with revocation of any club or organization, due to three or more semesters of inactivity, and

Whereas, under Section 2.4.4 of the SGA's By-Laws, a notice has been published in the Monroe Doctrine regarding the revocation of chartering for 2 weeks prior to the revocation of the club's Charter, and

Whereas, the following clubs have been inactive for three or more semesters: Student Organization of Women Leaders, and Peace and Justice Club, be it

Resolved, that the SGA Senate revoke the Charters from the Student Organization of Women Leaders and from the Peace and Justice Club.
