

# **Military Mentoring Program**

## **What is it?**

*In order to provide an increasingly Veteran-friendly environment for the hundreds of MCC students who are serving/who have served in the military (active duty, reserve or Guard), and their dependents, the Military Mentoring Program provides a way for military students to negotiate the demands and dynamics of civilian university-level study in the hope this will increase their completion, transferability and (ultimately) professional success.*

*Since serving as a MMP Mentor fulfills contractual advising requirements, consistent, active participation in student mentoring, faculty Mentor meetings and event support is expected.*

## **Who is eligible?**

*Any tenured, teaching Faculty member who is serving/who has served in the military, or who is a military family member, is welcome to apply to become a MMP Mentor.*

*Tenured Faculty members who have attended **all** of the STAR (Supporting Transitioning and Returning Service Members) workshops may also be eligible.*
