## **Resolutions for January 29, 2013 Student Government Association Senate Meeting**

### **Resolution To Approve Kyle Savarese to the position of Deputy Speaker Brighton Campus Student Government Association**

*Whereas*, under Article III, Section 6.C.2 of the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Constitution, the Senate shall elect a Speaker from among their number, by two-thirds vote, at scheduled meeting prior to the first day of classes in the fall semester. The Speaker shall then appoint a Deputy Speaker from the existing membership of the senate.

*Whereas*, such a vacancy exists at this time in the office of the Deputy Speaker, and

*Whereas*, Speaker Rabbil E. Jackson-Harris has nominated Kyle Savarese to the office of Deputy Speaker under Article III, Section 6 of the Constitution.

*Be it resolved* that the Senate confirms Speaker Rabbil E. Jackson-Harris's nomination of Kyle Savarese to the position of Deputy Speaker of the Brighton Campus Student Government Association for the 2012-2013 academic year.

### **Resolution to approve the petition for charter for the Human Behavioral Research Group**

*Whereas* article 2.4 of the Student Association by-laws reads "The Senate must charter all student clubs and organizations that seek recognition and meet all requirements for chartering set by the Senate and the by-laws,"

*And Whereas* the constitution committee has reviewed and approves the Constitution for the Human Behavioral Research Group.

*Resolved* that the Senate approves the charter for Human Behavioral Research Group.

### **Resolution to approve the funding of \$300.00 to BASIC**
