

Applying for Financial Aid

The **easy way** to complete the self-explanatory federal aid application (FAFSA) and the New York state aid application (TAP) for the 2012-2013 academic year:

1. Apply for federal aid at www.fafsa.gov
2. Apply for NY state aid at www.hesc.ny.gov
3. Have the following documents to complete the application(s) if applicable:
 - Student's 2011 Federal and New York State Tax Return
 - If you are a dependent student, Parents' 2011 Federal and New York State Tax Return if you are under 22 years of age.
 - You need to know the total amount of untaxed income received in 2011. If you, your spouse, or your parents (if applicable) received any untaxed income during 2011, such as child support you need report it in the financial aid application.

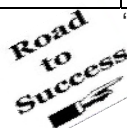
