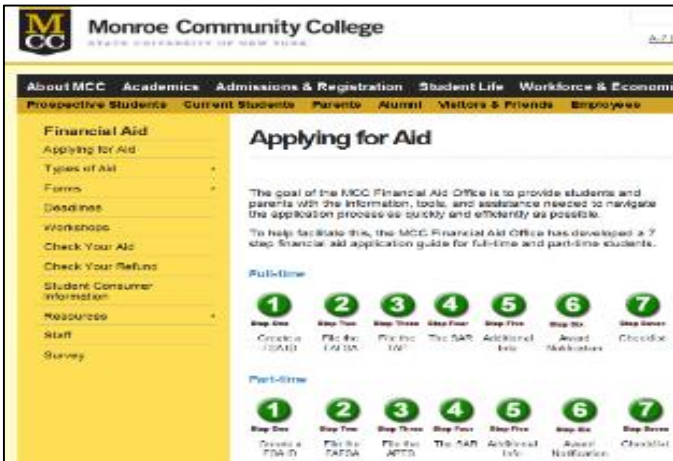

- To be better prepared to file the applications, please bring the following applicable documentation to the workshop:

**To apply for the 2015-2016 academic year (Summer 2015, Fall 2015 and Spring 2016):**

1. Student's 2014 Tax Return (Federal and New York State)
2. If you are a dependent student,
  - Parents' 2014 Tax Return (Federal and New York State).
  - Your parent/stepparent's date of birth, social security number and date of marital status.
3. You need to know the total amount of untaxed income received in 2014. If you, your spouse, or your parents (if applicable) received any untaxed income during 2014, such as child support you need to report it on the financial aid applications.
