Resolution to Override Presidential Veto

Whereas, under article 3, section 6.C.i of the Brighton Campus Student Government Association Constitution, by a two-thirds vote of the Senate present and voting, the Senate may override a Presidential veto, and

Whereas, President Jason Childers has vetoed the resolution to revoke club charters from the April 5, 2011 Brighton Campus Student Government Association Senate meeting, and

Whereas, the Senate has voted to approve the resolution to revoke charters, be it

Resolved, that the Senate overrides the Presidential veto and revokes the charters of Blackbird Entertainment, Campus Crusade for Christ, Creative Crew, Massage Therapy, Latin Pride, One Campus Challenge, and Peace & Justice effective immediately.

Resolution to amend the SGA Constitution by revising Articles 1-12
