International Student Application Instructions for Admission (for F-1 Students)

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications are recommended to be received by:

- August Admission - June 1
- January Admission - November 15

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Tuition and Fees** are \$11,000 per year. Total estimated cost of attendance (includes living expenses) is **\$24,525 per year**.
- **On-campus Housing.** Early application for on-campus housing is recommended due to high demand. You may only apply **after** receiving official acceptance to the college.
- **Calendar.** Spring 2022 semester begins in late January. The Fall 2022 semester begins at the end of August.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION ■ ■ ■

1. **Complete and submit the SUNY Application online (\$50 fee paid online).** Monroe Community College is part of SUNY (State University of New York). You will be prompted to select Monroe Community College within the application. Please follow the instructions provided on the SUNY application webpage <https://www.suny.edu/applysuny/>

2. **SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:** You must send the following documents directly to the college's Admission Office after submitting the online application:

HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS

Submit official high school transcripts (marks sheets, exam results, certificates). We will accept photocopied transcripts with an original signature or certification from a school official. Transcripts must be in English and include evidence of graduation or completion.

COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS (IF APPLICABLE)

Submit official transcripts of all post-secondary coursework. If you wish to transfer foreign college credit to MCC, you must use a credential evaluation service such as WES (World Education Services, www.wes.org).

TOEFL OR IELTS SCORES TO EVIDENCE ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) must be taken if English is not your native or first language. MCC requires a minimum score of 55 on internet-based TOEFL, or 5.5 band score on IELTS, to be considered for admission. MCC's school code for TOEFL test scores is 2429. Additionally, students also have the opportunity to take our Accuplacer ESL test remotely as an option to prove English language proficiency for the purpose of admission and course placement at MCC.

FINANCIAL DOCUMENTATION: REQUIRED FOR I-20 AND F-1 VISA ISSUANCE

1. **Submit official bank statements** showing availability of sufficient funds to pay for at least one year of study. The statements must be official, in English, and currently dated (no statements older than 2 months).
2. **Download, complete, and submit the:** [SUNY International Student Financial Statement](#)

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

Provide a copy of your passport.

PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION

After receiving official acceptance to the college, you must provide documentation of immunization against measles, mumps, and rubella. As a member of SUNY (State University of New York), MCC adheres to the COVID-19 vaccination mandate set by State government. HEALTH INSURANCE

All F-1 students are required to have health and accident insurance and are automatically enrolled in the college's health insurance plan.
