

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CITIZENS OF CANADA

Citizens of Canada are not required to obtain a U.S. visa to enter the United States. However, a U.S. Customs and Border Protections (CBP) officer will inspect your papers either at a Port of Entry (POE) at the airport, or upon entry to the U.S. at the Border.

You must bring the following documents with you to the border:

- SEVIS I-901 Fee Receipt
- Signed SEVIS I-20 document
- Passport
- Monroe Community College Acceptance Letter
- Copy of your financial documentation (bank statement, award letter, etc.)
