Description of Process

Judicial processes associated with the Student Conduct Policy are outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.

Selection and Appointment of the College Judicial Board

By authority granted to the College President by the Board of Trustees, the College President shall grant authority to the Provost and Vice President, Academic and Student Affairs and Director, Student Rights and Responsibilities, to oversee and manage the student conduct process. The Director, Student Rights and Responsibilities shall also appoint members of the College Judicial Board, comprised of individuals representing the diversity of the College's students, faculty, and staff. All members of the College Judicial Board shall participate in an interview process prior to appointment.

Membership shall consist of the following:

- A cross-divisional representation of faculty, both teaching and non-teaching;
- Staff members, as represented by the Support Staff Planning Council;
- Students, representing both the Brighton and Downtown Campuses; and
- A Board Chair, who falls within these guidelines, who shall be recommended by the Director, Student Rights and Responsibilities and appointed by the Provost and Vice President, Academic and Student Affairs.
