The Monroe County Public Safety Training Facility (PSTF), under the auspices of the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), will be holding a *Defensive Tactics Instructor Course* at 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, New York. This course prepares students to instruct topics and techniques related to law enforcement defensive tactics training.

Students who successfully complete this course will receive DCJS certification as a Defensive Tactics Instructor and four (4) college credits from Monroe Community College.

Prerequisites

- Active NYS police or peace officer certification
- DCJS General Topics Instructor certification

Required Attire and/or Equipment

- Attire (dress code)
 - o BDU pants and T-shirt
 - Footwear cross training or court shoes
 - Physical fitness training attire including foul weather gear
- Equipment
 - Water bottle
 - Duty belt with training handgun (red handled or hard plastic)
 - Handcuffs and key
 - Mouthpiece
 - Straight baton (fixed or collapsible)
 - Flash drive minimum 8 GB

Instructional Areas Include

- Daily physical fitness exercise recommendations
- Specificity in psycho-motor skill training
- Use of force and liability issues
- Handcuffing systems
- Pressure points
- Joint manipulations
- Active countermeasures
- Confrontational simulations
- Ground control
- Handgun retention
- Edged weapon awareness
- Straight baton familiarization

Graduation Requirements

- 90% attendance (policy set by Monroe Community College)
- Passing grade on written examination
