Rescue Task Force Train-the-Trainer

Date/Time: Nov. 9 – 11, 2022
8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

The Monroe County Public Safety Training Facility (PSTF), in partnership with the Monroe County Sheriff's Office and Monroe County Fire Bureau, will be holding a ***Rescue Task Force (RTF) Train-the-Trainer Course*** at 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, New York. This three-day course will bring police, fire, and EMS staff together to learn an integrated approach to mitigating incidents involving aggressive deadly behavior (ADB) and provide participants with the skills to train other first responders in RTF principles. Students will participate in practical exercises that include Warm Zone Operations, communication, team movement, and the triage, treatment, and transport of victims requiring high-level care.

Course attendance is restricted to police, fire, and EMS agencies within Monroe County. Upon completion, participants are expected to attend at least two joint-agency in-service training days annually. Students who successfully complete this course will receive two college credits from Monroe Community College.

Prerequisites

- NYS Emergency Services Instructor Level I certification, **or**
- NYS MPTC Law Enforcement General Topics Instructor certification are **preferred**

Required Attire and/or Equipment

- Days 1 and 2: Department approved training uniform; Day 3: Department duty uniform;
- Department issued portable radio and duty gun belt
- Plate carrier and ballistic plates if issued by department

Instructional Areas Include

- Aggressive Deadly Behavior (ADB) Response
- Rescue Task Force and Warm Zone Operations
- Tactical Emergency Casualty Care
- Law Enforcement and Fire Integration and Communication
- Command and Control and Unified Command

Graduation Requirements

- 90% attendance (policy set by Monroe Community College)
- Minimum 70% passing grade on written examination

Course Tuition and Fees

- Tuition: \$396.00 (per person)
- Estimated student fees: \$106.50 (Student fees may vary each semester)
- *Do not send a check or voucher prior to class.* Billing will occur at the completion of the course.

Note: Monroe Community College reserves the right to revise tuition and fees as necessary.
