## **Basic Investigative Photography**

**Date/Time:** November 14 – 18, 2022 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

The Monroe County Public Safety Training Facility (PSTF), under the auspices of the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), will be holding a *Basic Investigative Photography Course* at 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, New York. This course teaches the skills necessary to effectively photograph a crime scene and the evidence contained therein by means of classroom instruction and practical workshops. This course provides instruction in both film-based and digital photography however, students are strongly encouraged to bring and utilize digital equipment.

Students who successfully complete this course will receive two college credits from Monroe Community College.

### Prerequisites

- Active NYS police or peace officer certification
- Civilian employees of law enforcement agencies may attend with written authorization from their department.

### Required Attire and/or Equipment

- Attire (dress code)
  - o Business casual, OR
  - o Department designated uniform of the day
- Equipment
  - 35mm SLR or Digital SLR (preferred) capable of manual operation
  - Electronic flash detachable if available
  - Remote sync cord
  - Shutter release cable or remote control
  - o Lens with macro/close-up capability
  - o Flashlight
  - Owner's manual for camera and electronic flash
  - Batteries or power source for camera and flash (charger, battery packs)
  - Variety of scales
  - Evidence markers
  - $\circ$  35mm film (minimum of twenty rolls of 200 400ASA) not necessary if shooting digital
  - Memory Card (minimum of 512mb) two preferred not necessary if shooting film
  - o Tripod

- Operation of SLR film and digital cameras
- Fundamental techniques of photography
- Lighting techniques
- Guidelines for photographing a crime scene
- Photographing night and low light conditions
- Photographing evidence for comparison purposes
- Macro photography

## **Graduation Requirements**

- 90% attendance (policy set by Monroe Community College)
- 70 % passing grade on written examination
- 70% passing grade on proficiency test
