

Public Safety Training Facility Program Announcement

Firearms Instructor Course

Date/Time: April 24 thru May 5, 2023
8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The Monroe County Public Safety Training Facility (PSTF), under the auspices of the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), will be holding a ***Firearms Instructor Course*** at 1190 Scottsville Road, Rochester, New York. This course prepares MPTC certified general topics instructors to teach numerous subjects related to firearms including, safety, instructional techniques, shooting fundamentals, tactics, revolvers, semi-automatic pistols, shotguns, ammunition, equipment, use of force, critical incident trauma and legal issues. The program is presented in the classroom and on a firearms range.

Students who successfully complete this course will receive four (4) college credits from Monroe Community College.

Prerequisites

- Current NYS peace or police officer
- Three years of experience in a police or peace officer position that requires carrying a firearm
- Completion of the NYS DCJS Instructor Development Course
- Agency photo-identification will be required for admittance
- ***SHOOTING PRE-TEST:*** On the first day of the course, students will be required to fire a qualifying course of fire as described in the Firearms Training Unit of the NYS MPTC Basic Course for Police Officers. A minimum score of 90% is required.

Required Attire and/or Equipment

- Attire (dress code)
 - Battle Dress Uniform (BDU),
 - Training shirt (Polo preferred)
 - Baseball cap
- Equipment
 - Flash drive to obtain course materials
 - Duty gear: belt, handgun, holster, 3 spare magazines
 - 100 rounds .38 special practice ammunition
 - 100 rounds SIMUNITION AMO 9MM FX **Non-Marking Cartridges**
 - 1,000 rounds service pistol practice ammunition
 - 100 rounds service pistol ammunition
 - 200 rounds – frangible handgun ammunition – ***OPTIONAL***
 - 12-gauge shotgun (loaners are available)
 - 50 rounds 12-gauge slug
 - 100 rounds 12-gauge buckshot
 - 25 rounds frangible 12-gauge buckshot – ***OPTIONAL***
 - Protective vest
 - Hearing, eye & groin protection
 - Pen and notebook
 - Flashlight

Graduation Requirements

- 90% attendance (policy set by Monroe Community College)
- 70% passing grade on written examination
- Passing grade on proficiency test

Course Tuition and Fees

- Tuition: \$792.00 (per person)
- Estimated Student Fees: \$106.50 (Student fees may vary each semester)
- *It is **NOT** necessary to send a check or voucher prior to class.* Students will be billed at the completion of the course.
