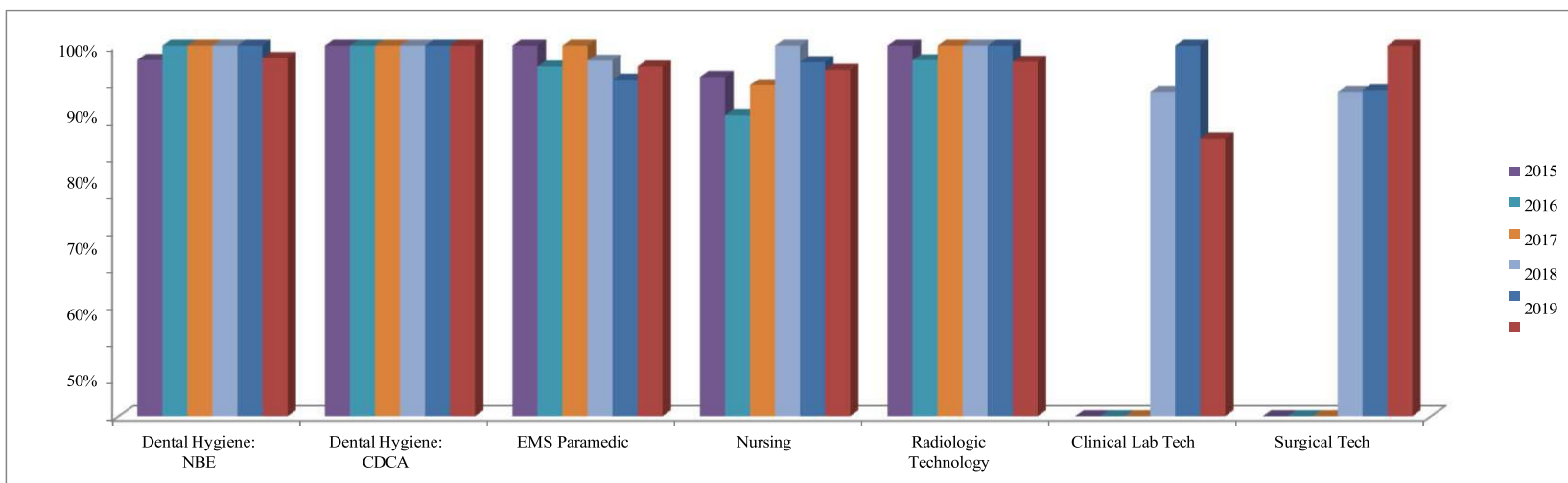

- Dental Hygiene - Dental Hygiene National Board Exam ("NBE") and Commission on Dental Competency Assessment ("CDCA," formerly Northeast Regional Boards)
- Nursing - NCLEX-RN Exam
- Radiologic Technology - American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (aka NYS Rad Tech Exam)
- Clinical Laboratory Technology - American Society for Clinical Pathology Medical Laboratory
- Surgical Technology - National Board of Surgical Technology & Surgical Assisting Certification
