

# Class of 2011 Profile

**Number of Graduates Surveyed = 2,915**

- 1,936 (65%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 749 (26%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 230 (8%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,884 alumni (a 64.6% response rate)

## Of the Survey Respondents:

- 1,770 (94%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the Career and Certificate Program graduates who are employed full-time, 90% are employed locally.
- Graduates were hired by 723 different employers
- 75% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 50% of whom transferred to a SUNY or CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 133 different colleges
