

## Class of 2012 Profile

A total of 2,852 Graduates were surveyed

- 1,927 (68%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 758 (27%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 167 (6%) were Certificate Program graduates

Survey responses were received from 1,460 alumni (a 51.2% response rate)

### Highlights of the Survey Respondents:

- 1,366 (94%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the Career and Certificate Program graduates who are employed full-time, 87% are employed locally.
- Graduates were hired by 617 different employers
- 73% of Transfer Program graduates are continuing their education, 60% of whom transferred to a SUNY or CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 116 different colleges
