

Class of 2013 Profile

A total of 2,792 Graduates were surveyed

- 1,908 (67%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 686 (25%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 198 (7%) were Certificate Program graduates

Highlights:

- 1,830 (66%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the Career and Certificate Program graduates who are employed full-time, 90% are employed locally.
- Graduates were hired by 567 different employers
- 30% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/ CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 189 different colleges

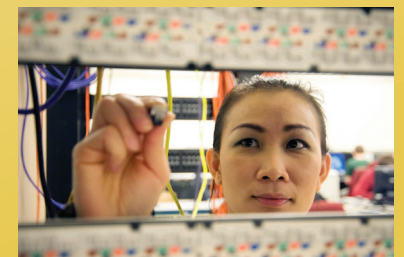
