

## Class of 2014 Profile

A total of 2,702 Graduates were surveyed

- 1,762 (65%) were Transfer Program (A.S. & A.A.) graduates
- 716 (27%) were Career Program (A.A.S.) graduates
- 224 (8%) were Certificate Program graduates

### Highlights:

- 1,680 (62%) are employed and/or are continuing their education
- Of the Career and Certificate Program graduates who are employed full-time, 88% are employed locally.
- Graduates were hired by 564 different employers
- 74% of the graduates who are continuing their education are doing so at a SUNY/ CUNY institution
- Graduates transferred to 145 different colleges
